Introduction

Himalaya Institute of Higher Education, under the governance of the Himalaya Educational Trust, aims to provide a holistic education to aspiring nurses by maintaining high academic standards. The college is affiliated with Bihar University of Health Science (BUHS), Patna, approved by Indian Nursing Council (INC), Govt. of India and recognized by the Bihar Nurses Registration Council (BNRC) & Health Department (Govt. of Bihar). This admission policy is designed to adhere to the guidelines of both regulatory bodies and to ensure a transparent and equitable process for the selection of candidates.

Courses on Offer

Himalaya Institute of Higher Education offers the following programs in nursing:

1. **B.Sc. Nursing (Bachelor of Science in Nursing)**
2. **GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery)**
3. **ANM (Auxiliary Nursing and Midwifery)**
4. **Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (Post Basic Bachelor of Science in Nursing)**
5. **M.Sc. Nursing (Master of Science in Nursing)**

Eligibility Criteria

1. B.Sc. Nursing

- **Age:** Candidates should have completed a minimum age of 17 years as on 31st December of the year of admission.
- **Educational Qualification:**
 - The candidate must have passed 10+2 (Intermediate) or its equivalent examination from a recognized board with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) as compulsory subjects along with English.
 - A minimum of 45% marks in aggregate in PCB subjects (40% for SC/ST candidates) & English, Medical Fitness: The candidate should be medically fit to pursue the course.

2. GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery)

- **Age:** The candidate must be between 17 to 35 years of age at the time of admission.
- **Educational Qualification:**
 - Must have passed 10+2 with any stream (Arts/Science/Commerce) from a recognized board. Preference will be given to those with Science (Biology) background. - Minimum 40% marks in the qualifying exam. For SC/ST candidates, the minimum required marks are 35%.
- **Medical Fitness:** The candidate must be physically and mentally fit to undergo the program.

3. ANM (Auxiliary Nursing and Midwifery)

- **Age:** The candidate must be between 17 to 30 years of age at the time of admission.
- **Educational Qualification:** -
 - Must have passed 10+2 in any stream from a recognized board.
 - The minimum marks requirement is 40% in the qualifying examination.
- **Medical Fitness:** The candidate must be medically fit to pursue the course.

4. Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (Post Basic Bachelor of Science in Nursing)

- **Age:** The candidate must be between 17 to 35 years of age at the time of admission.
- **Educational Qualification:**
 - Must have passed 10+2 with G.N.M. in any stream from a recognized board.
 - The minimum marks requirement is 40% in the qualifying examination.
- **Medical Fitness:** The candidate must be medically fit to pursue the course.

5. M.Sc. Nursing (Master of Science in Nursing)

- **Age:** The candidate must be between 17 to 35 years of age at the time of admission.
- **Educational Qualification:**
 - Must have passed B.Sc. Nursing, B.Sc. Hons. Nursing, P.B. B.Sc. Nursing in any stream from a recognized board.
 - The minimum marks requirement is 55% in the qualifying examination.
- **Medical Fitness:** The candidate must be medically fit to pursue the course.
 - The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
 - Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
 - No experience is required after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.

**Himalaya Institute of Higher Education offers the following
programs in Paramedics:**

1. B.P.T (Bachelor of Physiotherapy)
2. B.Oc.T (Bachelor of Occupational therapy)
3. B.H.M (Bachelor in Hospital Management)

1. B.P.T (Bachelor of Physiotherapy)

- **Age:** 17 years minimum
- **Eligibility:-** Passed in I.Sc / 10+2 or equivalent examinations with Biology from recognised board eligible for admission.

2. B.Oc.T (Bachelor of Occupational therapy)

-**Age:** 17 years minimum

-**Eligibility :-** Passed I.Sc / 10+2 an equivalent examinations with Biology from recognised board eligible for admission.

3. B.H.M (Bachelor in Hospital Management)

-**Age:** 17 years minimum

-**Eligibility :-** Passed 12th Standard in any Stream from recognised board is eligible.

Documents Required for Admission

At the time of admission, the candidate must submit original copies of the following documents along with two sets of photocopies:

1. Marksheet and passing certificate of 10+2 (Intermediate) or equivalent examination.
2. Transfer Certificate (TC) from the last institution attended.
3. Migration Certificate (for students from other boards or universities).
4. Caste Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
5. Domicile Certificate (if applicable).
6. Income Certificate (for EWS category).
7. Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
8. Character Certificate from the institution last attended.
9. Admit Card and Scorecard of the entrance exam (for B.Sc. Nursing candidates).
10. Passport-size photographs (as specified by the college)

Fee Structure

The fee structure for all nursing & paramedics courses will be decided by the management of the Himalaya Institute of Higher Education in accordance with the regulations of Indian Nursing Council (Govt. of India), Health Department (Govt. of Bihar), Bihar Nurses Registration Council and Bihar University of Health Science. Detailed fee information are made available on the official website.

Medical Examination

All selected candidates must undergo a medical examination to ensure they are fit to undertake the nursing course. Candidates found medically unfit will not be admitted to the program.

Anti-Ragging Policy

Preventive Measures:

- 1. Awareness Programs:** Regular anti-ragging workshops, seminars, and orientation programs for students and staff.
- 2. Anti-Ragging Committees:** Establishment of anti-ragging committees and squads to monitor and address incidents.

- 4. Helpline:** Providing a dedicated helpline number and email for reporting ragging incidents.
